


8% of NZ households are 'very worried' about dampness in their home (approx. 150,000 households). This is 5% homeowners but 12% of renters.




Almost 1 in 10 NZ households are concerned about significant mould in their home (approx. 215,000 households). 8% of homeowners vs. 19% of renters.

8% of NZ households have wet walls due to damp. condensation. 5% of homeowners vs. 14% of renters.

IMPACT OF MOULD, DAMPNESS **OR CONDENSATION**



For households who have significant areas of mould, concerns over dampness and/or condensation:

A fifth state it worsens the breathing of adults (approx. 180,000 households).

12% state it worsens the breathing of children (approx. 115,000 households).
