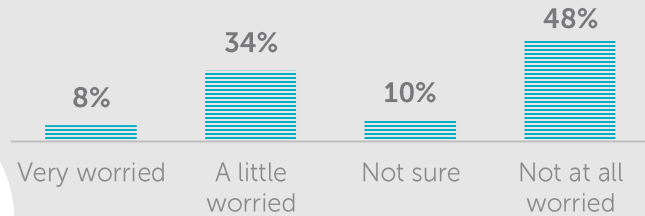


# The Aotearoa Housing Survey by AMI Insurance and Habitat for Humanity NZ

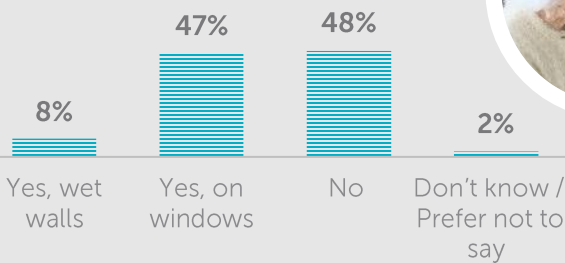
## DRYNESS

**8% of NZ households are 'very worried' about dampness in their home** (approx. 150,000 households). This is 5% homeowners but 12% of renters.

### WORRY ABOUT DAMPNESS



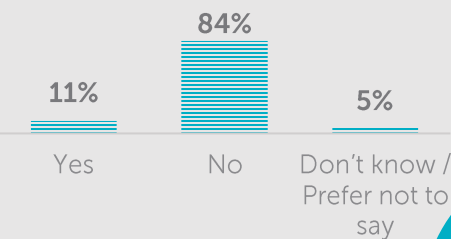
### EXPERIENCE CONDENSATION



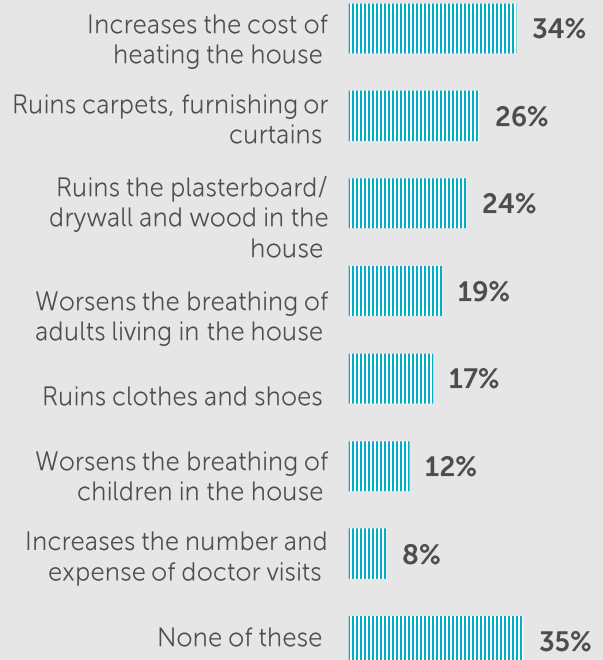
**Almost 1 in 10 NZ households are concerned about significant mould in their home** (approx. 215,000 households). 8% of homeowners vs. 19% of renters.

**8% of NZ households have wet walls due to damp, condensation.** 5% of homeowners vs. 14% of renters.

### IMPACT OF MOULD, DAMPNESS OR CONDENSATION

NZ households concerned about significant mould in their home



For households who have significant areas of mould, concerns over dampness and/or condensation:

**A fifth state it worsens the breathing of adults** (approx. 180,000 households).

**12% state it worsens the breathing of children** (approx. 115,000 households).
