

# The Aotearoa Housing Survey by AMI Insurance and Habitat for Humanity NZ

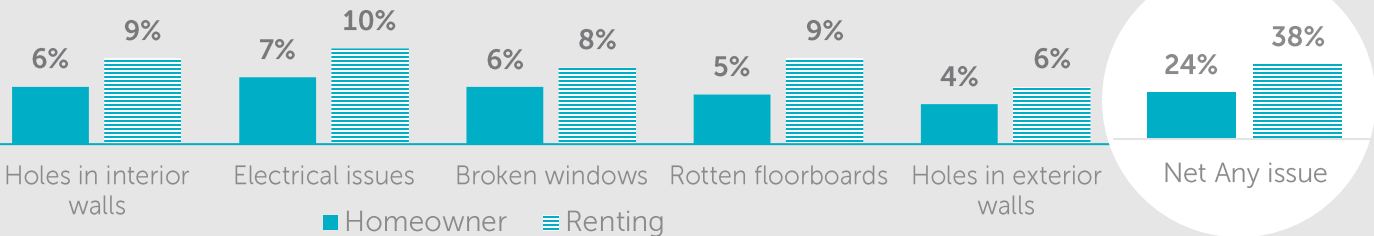
## SAFE + STRUCTURALLY SOUND

Almost a third (30%) of NZ households have internal issues in need of repair. Among those issues in need of repair, approximately a third (36%) have been an issue for over 3 years.



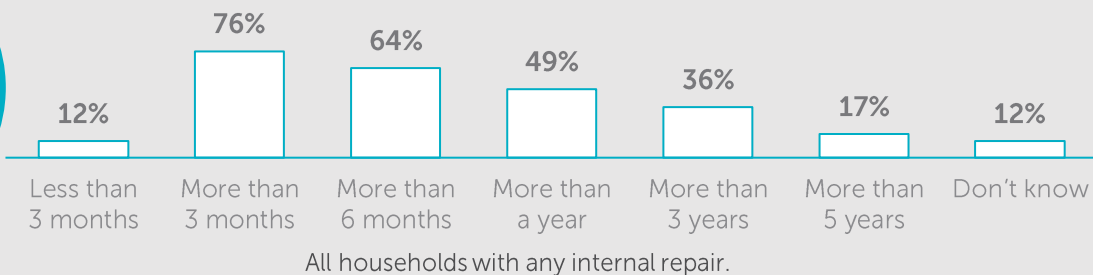
A quarter of New Zealand households currently have a water leak in their home, and 28% of these leaks have been an issue for over 3 years.

### INTERNAL REPAIRS NEEDED

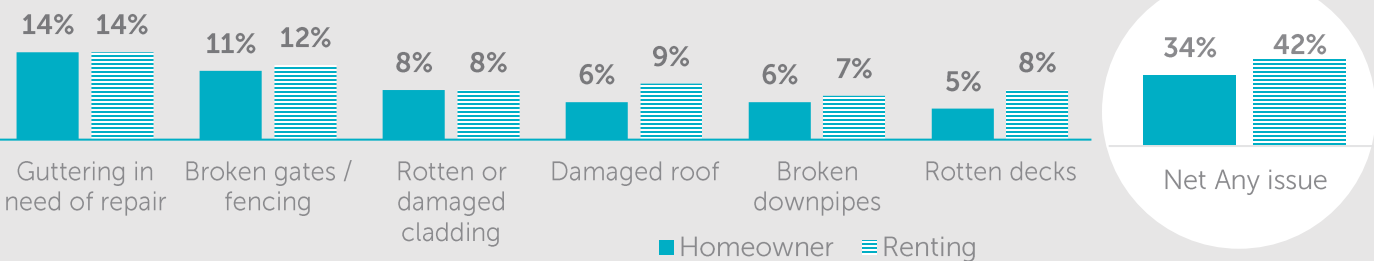

### LENGTH OF TIME INTERNAL REPAIR HAS BEEN AN ISSUE

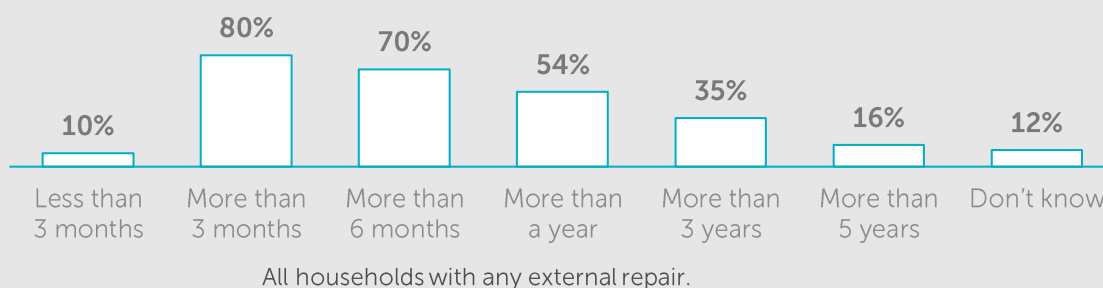


### EXTERNAL REPAIRS NEEDED

### LENGTH OF TIME EXTERNAL REPAIR HAS BEEN AN ISSUE

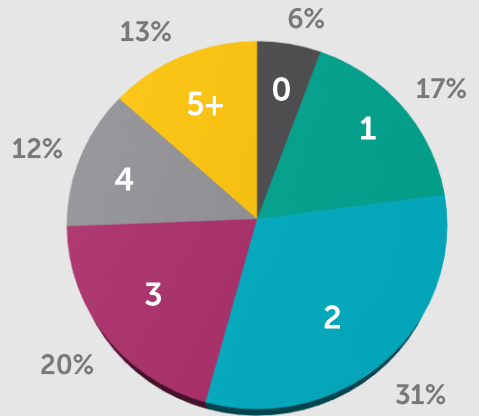


Over a third (38%) of New Zealand households have exterior issues in need of repair outside the home. Of these external issues, a third (35%) have been an issue for over 3 years.

## NUMBER OF SMOKE ALARMS IN THE HOME



The vast majority of NZ households have working smoke alarms in their home; however 6% (approx. 105,000 households) do not.



4 in 10 households also have a fire extinguisher and or an agreed fire evacuation plan

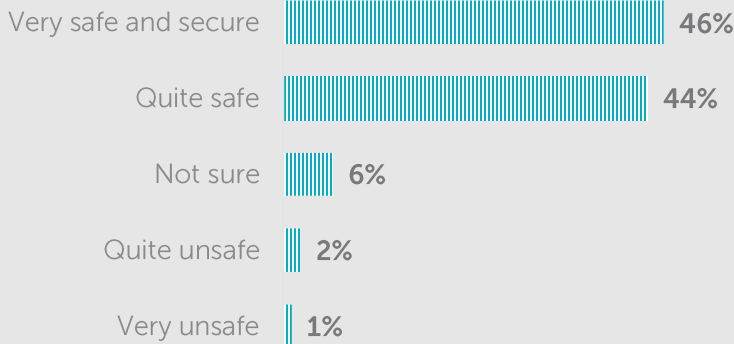
The majority of New Zealand households consider their home to be relatively safe and secure.

The majority of New Zealand households have locks on all doors but only two thirds have locks on all windows. Approximately 680,000 households do not have locks on all doors.
