14% of NZ households are concerned that their home is too cold in winter (approx. 265,000 households).

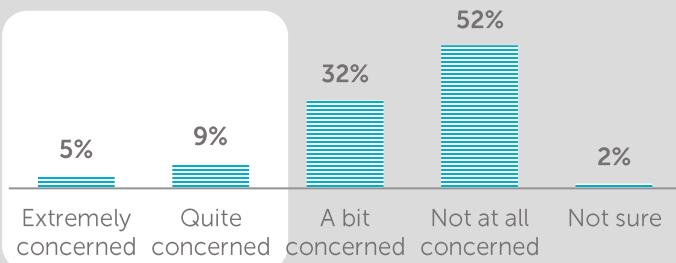
This is 10% of homeowners but 22% of renters.

19% of NZ households find it difficult to heat their home over winter (approx. 370,000 households).

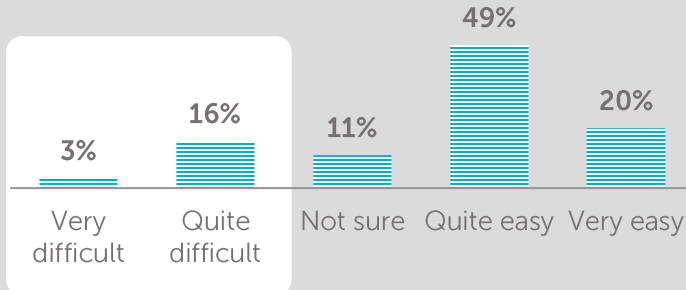
This is 15% of homeowners but 28% of renters.



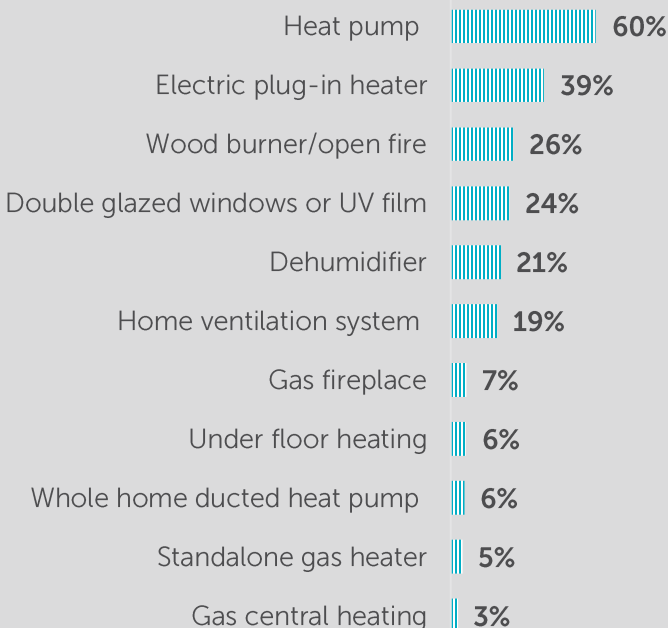
CONCERNED HOME IS TOO COLD



EXPERIENCE DIFFICULTY HEATING HOME

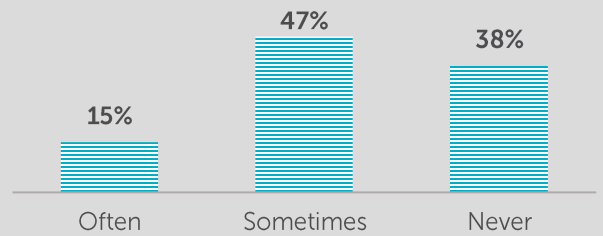


HOW NZ HOUSEHOLDS KEEP THEIR HOME WARM AND DRY



2/3rds of NZ households experience draughts from windows or doors with 15% experiencing this often.

New Zealand Home Insulation



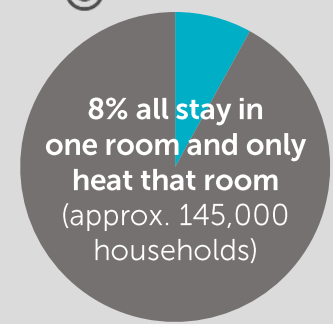
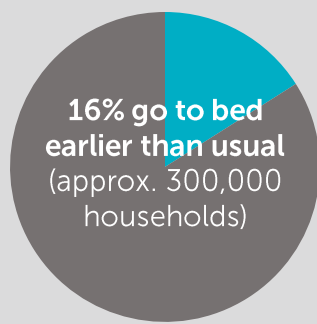
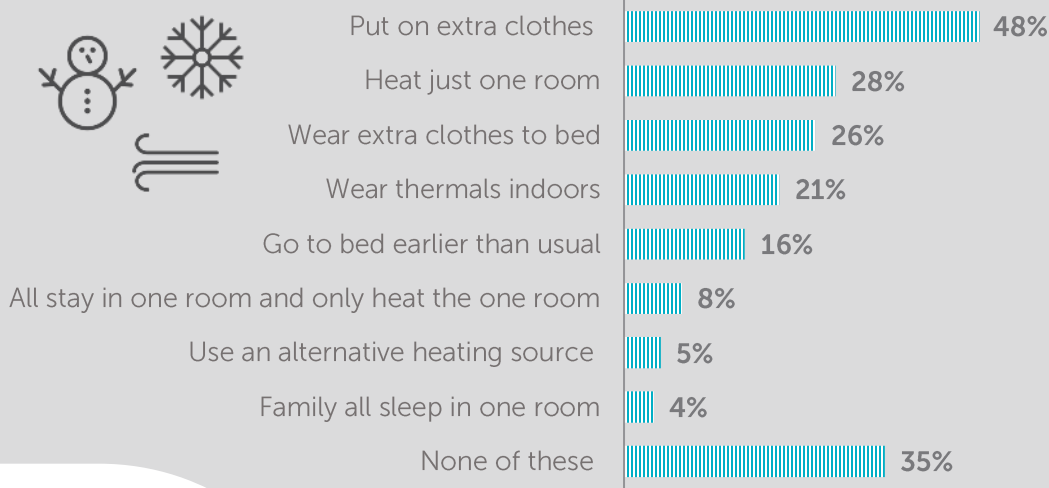
- 5%** Have underfloor insulation
- 33%** Have ceiling insulation
- 43%** Have both underfloor and ceiling
- 6%** Have no insulation (approx. 110,000 households)
- 13%** Not sure
- 29%** Have double lined curtains in all living areas and bedrooms
- 25%** In most of them
- 21%** Only in some
- 24%** Have no double lined curtains (approx. 460,000 homes)

A quarter of New Zealand households wear extra clothes to bed to help stay warm during winter.

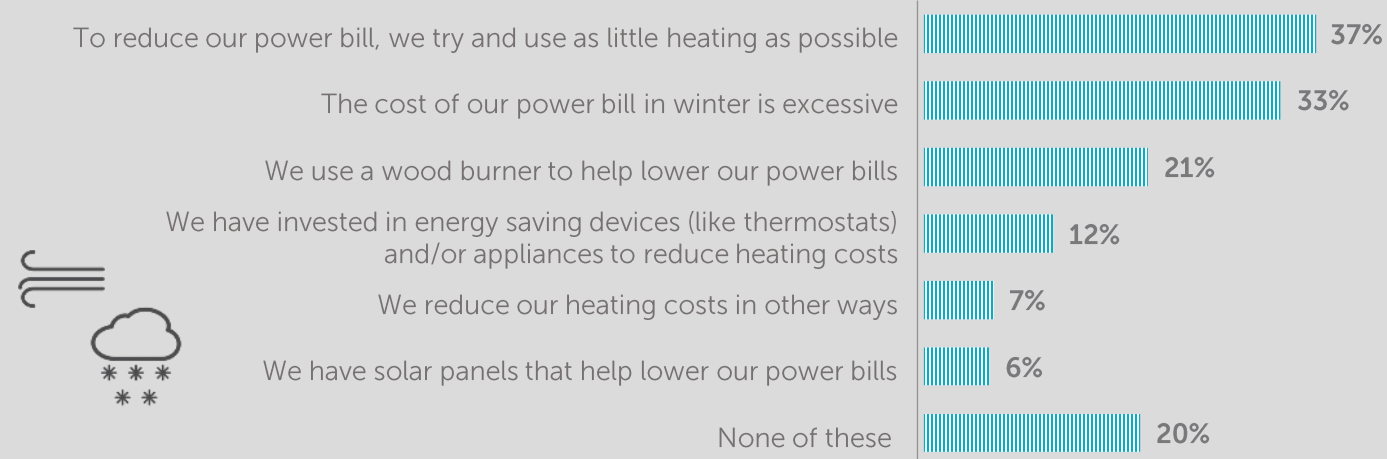
One third of New Zealand households state the cost of the power bill in winter is excessive.
